




The Archivo Shelf has been made to last and we hope it will serve you for many years. The metal threads and wooden parts can be easily separated and delivered to a suitable recycling depot.


5 YEAR WARRANTY




DISASSEMBLY


1. Before starting the disassembly, remove all objects from the unit and detach the shelf from the wall. To do so, remove the screws from the brackets that connect the shelf to the wall using a screwdriver.



2. Carefully flip the shelf upside down. Ensure you have an additional person to perform this action safely.



3. Begin the dissemably of the shelf with the feet. Remove the screws from the underside of the shelf by turning them counterclockwise. Once removed, detach each column and repeat this process for each level of the shelf.



- 4. Seperate the gliders from the feet by unscrewing them counterclockwise.
- 5. Finally, remove all the threaded inserts from the shelf boards as well as the feet. To do this, use a larger Allen key (not provided with the product) and turn it counterclockwise.
